




## **NWFP** classification WildFood Product/commodity **classification** system (HS, SITC, CN, FAO, WB etc.) Aggregation level of the product information • By species • by level of processing (raw, processed, end products) by commercial categories (size, purity, etc.) by origin (wild, cultivated, forest, agricultural products; physical or chemical extracts) • By commodity refinement (fresh, dried, frozen, ...) Functional classification (see the following slides) • Ecological classification, trade analysis, market behaviours, property rights regulations, etc.

## WFP data sources

## Scale of data source:

- International (ComTrade, FAOStat, EuroStat, US Bureau, World Bank, etc.)
- National/Regional (national statistical agency, category associations, etc.)
- Local/SME (public or private accountability)
- Case study (ad-hoc data collection)

Variables: production (supply), **trade**,  $\rightarrow$  consumption, i.e. demand: from data analysis (P+Im-Ex) to sample survey approaches)
